THE GOSPEL

"When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory. All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and he will put the sheep at his right hand and the goats at the left. Then the king will say to those at his right hand, 'Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink. I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me.' Then the righteous will answer him, 'Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and gave you clothing? And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?'And the king will answer them, 'Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me." Then he will say to those at his left hand, You that are accursed, depart from me into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not give me clothing, sick and in prison and you did not visit me.' Then they also will answer, 'Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not take care of you?' Then he will answer them, 'Truly I tell you, just as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me.' And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life."

"How do I become a Saint?" - Fr Sam Wehbe

This week, we celebrate the Sunday of the Righteous and the Just. Who are they? How did they become saints and how can we become saints? The righteous and the just are those who gave everything to God and others: They gave faith, piety and love; holy action, service and sacrifice; time, energy and tears; simplicity, humility, tenderness and forgiveness. They gave everything they had here so that they could gain everything in heaven. They gave their earthly life so that they could gain eternal life. They sacrificed this world so that they could be in the next world. They felt the pain and need of others, saw Jesus in them and helped them. For this reason they became saints. Jesus, help us to give You and others everything with joy and humility, especially love and service. Help us to see and serve you in the poor and needy so that one day we become righteous and just. Amen.

St Maroun - 9 February

The father of the Maronite Church, St Maroun was born in the middle of the 4th century and was a priest who later became a hermit, retiring to the mountain of Taurus near Antioch. His piety and miracles attracted many followers, and drew attention

throughout the Roman empire. St Maroun is considered the Father of the spiritual and monastic movement now called the Maronite Church. Saint Maroun spent all of his life on a mountain in the region of Cyrrhus in Syria. It is believed that the place was called "Kefar-Nabo" on the mountain of Ol-Yambos, making it the cradle of the Maronite movement. St Maroun was a mystic who started this new ascetic-spiritual method that attracted many people in Syria and Lebanon to become his disciples. He sought not only to cure the physical ailments that people suffered from, but had a great quest for nurturing and healing the "lost souls" of both pagans and Christians of his time. After his death in the year 410 AD, his spirit and teachings lived on through his disciples.

Bishop's Message - Golden Jubilee Year Update and Feast of St Maroun

Brothers and Sisters,

It is with a spirit of joy that we approach the Feast of St Maroun, and the launch of our Eparchy's Golden Jubilee.

I hope to see as many of you as possible at St Maroun's Cathedral in Redfern on the evening of Thursday 9 February to welcome the relics of Saints Maroun, Charbel, Rafqa, Nehmetallah and Mary MacKillop. The arrival of the relics will be followed by a solemn mass at 7pm.

The relics will remain at St Maroun's until Friday night, after which they will travel to St Maroun's Parish in Brisbane and then St Maroun's in Adelaide. I encourage you all to make the time to visit with and venerate our Saints, who continue to inspire our journey of holiness.

Our Maronite Liturgical Calendar - Sunday of the Righteous and the Just

On this second Sunday of Commemoration, the Maronite Church remembers the Righteous and the Just and guides us to reflect on the Gospel of the Judgment of the Nations as written by St Matthew (25:31-46). We read about the separation of the sheep from the goats.

The sheep, who have shown kindness and compassion to the hungry, the thirsty, the stranger, the naked, the sick, and the imprisoned, are welcomed into the kingdom of heaven. On the other hand, the goats, who neglected these needs, are sent away to eternal punishment.

This passage reminds us that our actions towards those in need, no matter how small, have eternal significance. Jesus shows us that it is not only what we believe but also how we live out our faith that matters. Our love for others, especially those who are marginalized, is a reflection of our love for God.

We must strive to be a blessing to those around us. Every act of kindness is an opportunity to serve Christ and bring glory to His name. We are reminded of this reality on this Sunday of the Righteous and the Just, who are the good sheep to the right of the Lord. Reading about the final judgment should never scare us; it should rather push us to better live the present. In His mercy and His patience, God offers us to grow in faith each day to recognize Him in the poor and in the little ones.

This Sunday is an opportunity for us to reflect on the lives of the saints and the holy people who preceded us, to imitate their faith and devotion. It also serves as a reminder that we are all called to be saints. May we be recognised as good and faithful servants when we stand before the Son of Man.
