THE GOSPEL

Now on that same day two of them were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem, and talking with each other about all these things that happened. While they were talking and discussion, Jesus himself came near and went with them, but their eyes were kept from recognizing him. And he said to them, "What are you discussing with each other while you walk along?" They stood still looking sad. Then one of them, whose name was Cleopas, answered him, "Are you the only stranger in Jerusalem who does not know the things that have taken place there in these days?" He asked them, "What things?" They replied, "The things about Jesus of Nazareth, who was a prophet mighty in deed and word before God and all the people, and how our chief priests and leaders handed him. But we had hoped that he was the crucified him. But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel. Yes, and besides all this, it is now the third day since these things took place. Moreover, some women of our group astounded us. They were at the tomb early this morning, and when they did not find his body there, they came back and told us that they had indeed seen a vision of angels who said that he was alive. Some of those who were with us went to the tomb and found it just as the women had said; but they did not see him." Then he said to them: "Oh have feeligh you and how slow of them, "Oh, how foolish you are, and how slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have declared! Was it not necessary that the Messiah should suffer these things and then enter into his should." Then beginning with Message and all the snould suffer these things and then enter into his glory?" As they came near the village to which they were going, he walked ahead as if he were going on. But they urged him strongly, saying "Stay with us, because it is almost evening and the day is now nearly over," So he went in to stay with them. They said to each other, "Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us on the road, while he was opening the Scriptures to us?" On the third Sunday of the Resurrection, we reflect on the Lord Jesus appearing to the two disciples of Emmaus and walking with them. The two



disciples were disappointed with what hap-pened to Jesus so they decided to run away from Jerusalem and forget past memories with Him. Suddenly Jesus appeared and walked with them towards Emmaus and started to explain to them the Books; they did not know Him until He broke the bread. Jesus did not stop them at the start, but walked with them in their journey and took his time with them to help them to decide by themselves to change the direction and return to Jerusalem and proclaim the resurrection, the hope and the joy. As for us, we are called to be conscious that Christ is walking with us always. He is with us to help us when we experience difficulties, sorrow or pain, poverty or injustice, injury or sickness, or problems, and He is with us also when we are happy, strong, successful and in peace. The Lord asks us to use the same method with each other: To walk with each other and to accompany and help each other always.

Bishop's Corner — 3rd Sunday of Resurrection

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

We reflect this Sunday on the passage about the appearance of the Lord to two disciples on the Road to Emmaus. These two men, disappointed in their expectation of the Messiah who was to save Israel, leave Jerusalem sad and discouraged.

Jesus arrives where they do not expect Him: in the middle of their journey, in the middle of their despair. And they are so sad, so focused on their disappointment, their personal suffering, that they cannot recognize the Lord. The Lord is patient in helping them realize that what happened had to happen.

However, He does not stop there. He joins them for dinner and reveals Himself in the breaking of the bread, because their hearts are now ready to receive the truth of the presence of God, the Risen Lord! Once they recognise Him, Jesus leaves. His living presence remains with them and this good news of the Risen Christ is such a source of joy, that they return to tell the Apostles.

How does this Gospel connect with us in our lives? We know that Jesus is risen; we know that He is present in the Eucharist. But do we really live in the presence of Jesus living in us, living at the heart of our lives? Or are we like the disciples on the road to Emmaus, focussed on our suffering, centred on ourselves, that we no longer see the Lord and recognise His presence? When things get tough, do we drop our prayer life or do we draw closer to Jesus?

On this Sunday, let us remember that He is always there, He joins us on our journey and He manifests Himself in many ways, but it is us who do not recognise Him. The Lord will wait patiently until we recognise Him, invite Him and welcome Him.

في اليوم عينه، كان إثنان من التلاميذ ذاهبين إلى قرية تدعى عمَّاوس، تبعد نحو سبعة أميالٍ عن أورشليم. وكانا يتحدثان بكل تلك الأمور التي حدثت. وفيما هما يتحدثان وبتساءلان، إذا يسوع نفسه قد اقترب مهما، وراح يسير معهما. ولكن أعينهما أمسكت عن معرفته. أمّا هو فقال لهما: "ما هذا الكلام الَّذي تتحادثان به، وأنتما تسيران؟" فوقفا عابسين وأجاب أحدهما، واسمه كليوباس، فقال له: "هل أنت وحدك غربب عن أورشليم، فلا تعلم ما حدث فها هذه الأيام؟" فقال لهما: "وما هي؟" فقالا له: "ما يتعلّق بيسوع النّاصري، الّذي كان رجلاً نبيّاً قوباً بالقول والفعل، قدّام الله والشعب كلّه. وكيف أسلمه أحبارنا ورؤساؤنا ليُحكم عليه بالموت، وكيف صلبوه! وكنا نحن نرجو أن يكون هو الذي سيفدي إسرائيل. ولكن مع هذا كلُّه، فهذا هو اليوم الثالث بعد تلك الأحداث لكن بعض النساء من جماعتنا أدهشننا، لأنبّن ذهبّن إلى القبر عند الفجر، ولم يجدن جسد يسوع، فرجعيّن وقلّن إنَّهنّ شاهدَّن ملائكة تراءوا لهنّ وقالوا إنّه حيّ! ومضى قوم من الذين معنا إلى القبر، فوجدوه هكذا كما قالت النساء، وأما يسوع فلم يروه". فقال لهما يسوع: "يا عديمي الفهم، وبطيعً القلب في الإيمان بكل ما تكلُّم به الأنبياء! أما كان يجب على المسيح أن يعاني تلك الآلام، ثمّ يدخل في مجده؟ وفسّر لهما ما يتعلّق به في كل الكتب المقدّسة، مبتدئاً بموسى وجميع الأنبياء. واقتربا من القربة التي كانا ذاهبين إليها، فتظاهر يسوع بأنه ذاهب إلى مكان أبعد. فتمسكا به قائلين: "أمكث معنا" فقد حان المساء، ومال الهار" فدخل ليمكث معهما. وفيما كان متكئاً معهما، أخذ الخبز، وبارك وكسر، وناولهما. فانفتحت أعينهما، وعرفاه، فإذا هو قد تواري عنهما. فقال أحدهما للآخر: "أما كان قلبنا مضطرماً فينا، حين كان يكلَّمنا في الطَّريق، ويشرح لنا الكتب؟"وقاما في تلك الساعة عينها، ورجعا إلى أورشليم، فوجدا الأحد عشر والذين معهم مجتمعين، وهم يقولون: "حقًا إن الربّ قام، وتراءى لسمعان!". أما هما فكانا يخبران بما حدث في الطريق، وكيف عرفا يسوع عند كسر الخبز.
