THE GOSPEL

The next day John again was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he exclaimed, "Look, here is the Lamb of God!"

The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. When Jesus turned and saw them following, he said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi" (which translated means Teacher), "where are you staying?" He said to them, "Come and see." They came and saw where he was staying, and they remained with him that day. It was about four o'clock in the afternoon. One of the two who heard John speak and followed him was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his brother Simon and said to him. "We have found the Messiah" (which is translated Anointed). He brought Simon to Jesus, who looked at him and said, "You are Simon son of John. You are to be called Cephas" (which is translated Peter).

THE EPISTLE

We do not proclaim ourselves; we proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your slaves for Jesus' sake. For it is the God who said. "Let light shine out of darkness." who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ. But we have this treasure in clay jars, so that it may be made clear that this extraordinary power belongs to God and does not come from us. We are afflicted in every way, but not crushed; perplexed, but not driven to despair; persecuted, but not forsaken; struck down, but not destroyed; always carrying in the body the death of Jesus, so that the life of Jesus may also be made visible in our bodies. For while we live, we are always being given up to death for Jesus' sake, so that the life of Jesus may be made visible in our mortal flesh. So death is at work in us, but life in you. But just as we have the same spirit of faith that is in accordance with Scripture -"I believed, and so I spoke" — we also believe, and so we speak, because we know that the one who raised the Lord Jesus will raise us also with Jesus, and will bring us with you into his presence. Yes, everything is for your sake, so that grace, as it extends to more and more people, may increase thanksgiving, to the glory of God.

Jesus asked this question to the 2 disciples of John the Baptist who followed him (John 1: 35-42). Their response was that they wished to be with him. Then he said to them: "Come and see". After experiencing being with him, they came back overjoyed and started to preach that they found the Messiah and Saviour. Today, Jesus is looking at me and asking: "What are you looking for? What do you need for your

life?" And if my response is: "I'm searching for joy, love, peace, rest, good health, success, holiness..." Jesus will say to me: "All you need is to come to me and see", which means to love Him, listen to Him, and live with Him ... and He will grant me what I asked for.

Lord, grant us that we will always search for You and be with You, then we will find what we are looking for. Amen

Saint Anthony The Great - 17 January

St Anthony The Great, was born in Hellenized Egypt around 251 AD and reposed in 356 AD. He is also known as St. Anthony of Egypt and St. Anthony of the Desert. Having inherited his parent's sizable wealth, at age 20 after insuring his younger sister was taken care of, he took

to heart Christ's admonition and sold all his remaining riches, gave all his wealth to the poor, and went in poverty into the desert to follow Christ, eventually living in solitude in a cave for many years. He is considered the Father of Christian monasticism, the first of the Desert Fathers of ancient Christianity. The asceticism (spiritual athleticism) St. Anthony was a fierce defender of our Trinitarian Faith and protected the Holy Church from the ancient heresy of Arianism, which falsely taught that Christ did not share in God the Father's nature. It is due to St. Anthony and other Church Fathers like him, that we have been Traditioned (handed down) the one True and Apostolic Faith. St. Anthony taught to the other Desert Fathers is followed to this day at the same hermitage he founded some 1700 years ago located between the Nile and the Red Sea, Dayr Mārī Antonios. May his prayers be among us.

مار أنطونيوس الكبير - ١٧ كانون الثاني

وُلد أنطونيوس في مصر نحو السنة ٢٥١ من أبوين مسيحيَّين تقيَّين. توفي والداه تاركين له أختاً دونه سِنَّا، فكان لها الأخ الشفيق المحب. سمع يوماً كلام الإنجيل المقدس:" إن كنت تريد ان تكون كاملاً فاذهب وبع كل شيء لك واعطيه للمساكين فيكون لك كنز في السماء وتعال اتبعني" فكان لهذه الآية وقعُها العميق في قلبه، فمضي فباع ما يملك، تاركاً لشقيقته نصيها، ووزَّع ما خصَّه على

الكنائس والفقراء. واعتزل الدنيا. وأخذ يزور النسّاك، صارفاً أكثر أوقاته بالصلاة والتأمّل ومطالعة الأسفار المقدّسة. فحسده الشيطان واخذ يجرّبه. امَّا انطونيوس فكان ينتصر على هذه التجارب بالصّوم والصلاة والتأمل. ولم يكن يقتات بسوى الخبز والملح وقليل من الماء. وكان أنطونيوس يزور الأديار وبثبّت الرهبان في دعوتهم. وفي السنة ٢١١ ثار الإضطهاد بشدة على المسيحيين، فهبَّت نار الغيرة في قلب أنطونيوس فسار الي الإسكندرية يشدد عزائم الشهداء وبرافق المسيحيين الى المحاكم وبشجّعهم على الثبات في الإيمان. ولما خمدت نار الإضطهاد، عاد الى صومعته يتابع حياته النسكية. ومنَّ الله عليه بموهبة شفاء الامراض وطرد الشياطين، فتقاطر الناس اليه افواجاً فخاف من روح الكبرياء، فهرب الى برّبة تيبايس العليا. وبعد ان عثر رهبانه عليه زار أدياره وحثَّ الرؤساء والرهبان على مواصلة السير في طربق الكمال، وعاد الى خلوته. رقد بسلام في ١٧ك٢ سنة ٣٥٦وحسننا ان نذكر المناسك والنساك الكثر الذين اقتدوا به متخذين طريقته في لبنان. وما وادي قاديشا، ودير مار أنطونيوس قزحيا التاريخي الشهير بمعجزاته في طرد الشياطين الا دليل على ما لهذا القدّيس من الشفاعة لدى الله ومن الثقة والكرامة في قلوب اللبنانيين.والرهبانيات المارونيات الثلاث أبت إلا ان تدعى باسمه المبارك منذ نشأتها وان تتبع طربقته النسكية. ولذلك حق له ان يُدعى "كوكب البرية" ومجد الحياة الرهبانية وشفيع الجماعات والأفراد في كل مكان وزمان. صلاته معنا. آمين.

Bishop's Corner—Second Sunday after Epiphany

Dear Brothers and Sisters.

The Gospel we read on this Second Sunday after the Epiphany is a rich Gospel. We read that John the Baptist continues to point his followers towards Jesus, "the Lamb of God".

John, who is the forerunner of Christ, does not hold back his own disciples, he lets them go to follow Jesus. For John, it was never a matter of followers or competition but only of preparing the way for the Lord, the Messiah.

This is an important lesson for us in our parishes and in our communities, where sometimes we think we are in competition with each other. We belong to a certain group or a certain community, and we feel it is a competition to have the largest number of members or participants. That is a not what our Christian community should be about. We are all called to follow God's call as it presents itself and where it leads us. We must therefore, like John, learn to let others follow God's call in their lives and rejoice for them.

John and Andrew, the two young fishermen, followed Jesus. He turns around to ask them what they want. And they, surprised by the question, answer Him: "Rabbi, where are you staying?". The Lord answers them: "Come and you will see" (Jn 1:39). He invites them to follow him, to look and to contemplate.

After spending time with Jesus, we read that Andrew found his brother Simon and told him what they had seen and experienced: "We have found the Messiah!" (Jn 1:41). In the Christian life, the essential thing is to allow oneself to be looked at by Jesus, to go and see where He lives, to live with Him and to share in His love. And then our hearts would be set on fire by the love and joy He alone gives us that we cannot but announce this to those around us.

The Evangelist John then tells us that Jesus changes Simon's name to Kefa (Peter). Even though Simon does not know it yet, Jesus knows it, and we know that later He will say to him: "And I tell you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church..." (Matt 16:18). When God calls someone to follow him, there is inner transformation, that will take place gradually over the course of the journey. We must enter into this transforming call of God, with complete confidence.

Friends, the past few weeks have been so difficult for many families in Australia with uncertainty and worry about the health of our loved ones. In these moments of hardship, let us never forget that Our Lord is with us. Let us allow Him to use these challenges to transform us, and may we continue to protect one another and especially the most vulnerable amongst us.
