THE GOSPEL

When the Son of Man comes in his glory, and all the angels with him, then he will sit on the throne of his glory. All the nations will be gathered before him, and he will separate people one from another as a shepherd separates the sheep from the goats, and he will put the sheep at his right hand and the goats at the left. Then the king will say to those at his right hand, "Come, you that are blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world; for I was hungry and you gave me food, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you welcomed me, I was naked and you gave me clothing, I was sick and you took care of me, I was in prison and you visited me." Then the righteous will answer him, "Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry and gave you food, or thirsty and gave you something to drink? And when was it that we saw you a stranger and welcomed you, or naked and gave you clothing? And when was it that we saw you sick or in prison and visited you?" And the king will answer them, "Truly I tell you, just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me." Then he will say to those at his left hand, "You that are accursed, depart from me into the eternal fire prepared for the devil and his angels; for I was hungry and you gave me no food, I was thirsty and you gave me nothing to drink, I was a stranger and you did not welcome me, naked and you did not give me clothing, sick and in prison and you did not visit me." Then they also will answer, "Lord, when was it that we saw you hungry or thirsty or a stranger or naked or sick or in prison, and did not take care of you?" Then he will answer them, "Truly I tell you, just as you did not do it to one of the least of these, you did not do it to me." And these will go away into eternal punishment, but the righteous into eternal life.

Bishop's Corner - Year of Hope - 7th Sunday after the Cross

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

This Sunday, the last of the Season of the Glorious Cross, we hear Jesus telling us again about the Final Judgment and how it will be a judgment of the depths of our love. Next Sunday, our Maronite Church begins a new liturgical year with the Sunday of the Consecration and Renewal of the Church.

As Catholic Christians and followers of Christ, our love must manifest in our works and actions, more than in mere words. And this Sunday's gospel illustrates this very well. Every work of charity we do, we do to Christ Himself: "For I was hungry, and you gave me food; I was thirsty, and you gave me something to drink; I was a stranger, and you welcomed me..." (Mt 25: 34-36). Even more: "just as you did it to one of the least of these who are members of my family, you did it to me." (Mt 25:40).

This Gospel passage shows us a new image of what the judgment will be like. The kingship of Christ is not based on power, influence or force. In the Lord's kingdom: love will have the final word. Jesus shows us that the meaning of royalty and power is to place oneself at the service of others. He is the Master, the Lord, and the King. He confirmed these truths throughout His mission on earth. And despite this, our loving Lord exercised His role as Master by washing the feet of his disciples, and He reigned by laying down His life for those He loved. His rule begins in a humble cradle in Bethlehem and ends on the Cross, His throne.

Throughout this whole Season of the Glorious Cross, there has been a constant reminder to us: our actions do matter. Our life on earth is a journey towards God, and our actions are the means we take to reach the final goal. Christ will judge us not only for the evil we have done, but above all for the good that we have not done. The sin of omission is a most serious sin: it is to persist in not doing the good that we can do. On our journey to our heavenly home, the sin of omission is similar to walking in the wrong direction. When we think of others more than ourselves, we draw closer to the heart of Christ, and we become worthy to take our inheritance, the kingdom prepared for us since the creation of the world (Mt 25:34).

Let us commit this week to place others before ourselves, to look for ways to do good and to serve. Let us seek the face of the Lord in every person we encounter and remember that the only measure that counts is our love!

قَالَ الرَّبُّ يَسُوعُ: "مَتَى جَاءَ ابْنُ الْإِنْسَانِ فِي مَجْدِهِ، وَجَمِيعُ الْمَلَائِكَةِ مَعَهُ، يَجْلِسُ عَلَى عَرْشِ مَجْدِهِ. وَتُجْمَعُ لَدَيْهِ جَمِيعُ الْأُمَمِ، فَيَمَيِّزُ بَعْضَهُمْ مِنْ بَعْضٍ، كَمَا يُمَيِّزُ الرَّاعِي الْخِرَافَ مِنَ الْجِدَاءِ. وَيُفْقِمُ الْخِرَافَ عَنْ يَمِينِهِ وَالْجِدَاءَ عَنْ شِمَالِهِ. حِينَئِذٍ يَقُولُ الْمَلِكُ لِلَّذِينَ عَنْ يَمِينِهِ: تَعَالَوْا، يَا مُبَارِكِي أَبِي، ارْثُوا الْمُلْكَوتَ الْمُعَدَّ لَكُمْ مُنْذُ إِنشَاءِ الْعَالَمِ، لِأَنِّي جُعْتُ فَأَطْعَمْتُمُونِي، وَعَطِشْتُ فَسَقَيْتُمُونِي، وَكُنْتُ غَرِيبًا فَأَوْثَمْتُمُونِي، وَغُرِيًّا فَكَسَوْتُمُونِي، وَمَرِيضًا فَرَزَمْتُمُونِي، وَمَحْبُوسًا فَأَتَيْتُمُونِي. حِينَئِذٍ يُجِيبُهُ الْأَبْرَارُ قَائِلِينَ: يَا رَبِّ، مَتَى رَأَيْنَاكَ جَائِعًا فَأَطْعَمْنَاكَ، أَوْ عَطِشْنَا فَسَقَيْنَاكَ؟ وَمَتَى رَأَيْنَاكَ غَرِيبًا فَأَوْثَمْنَاكَ، أَوْ غُرِيًّا فَكَسَوْنَاكَ؟ وَمَتَى رَأَيْنَاكَ مَرِيضًا أَوْ مَحْبُوسًا فَأَتَيْنَا إِلَيْكَ؟ فَيُجِيبُ الْمَلِكُ وَيَقُولُ لَهُمْ: أَلْحَقْ أَقُولُ لَكُمْ: كُلُّ مَا عَمِلْتُمُوهُ لِأَحَدٍ إِخْوَتِي هَؤُلَاءِ الصِّغَارِ، فَلِي عَمِلْتُمُوهُ! ثُمَّ يَقُولُ لِلَّذِينَ عَنْ شِمَالِهِ: إِذْهَبُوا عَنِّي، يَا مَلَاعِينِ، إِلَى النَّارِ الْأَبَدِيَّةِ الْمُعَدَّةِ لِإِبْلِيسَ وَجُنُودِهِ؛ لِأَنِّي جُعْتُ فَمَا أَطْعَمْتُمُونِي، وَعَطِشْتُ فَمَا سَقَيْتُمُونِي، وَكُنْتُ غَرِيبًا فَمَا أَوْثَمْتُمُونِي، وَغُرِيًّا فَمَا كَسَوْتُمُونِي، وَمَرِيضًا وَمَحْبُوسًا فَمَا رَزَمْتُمُونِي! حِينَئِذٍ يُجِيبُهُ هَؤُلَاءِ أَيْضًا قَائِلِينَ: يَا رَبِّ، مَتَى رَأَيْنَاكَ جَائِعًا أَوْ عَطِشْنَا أَوْ غَرِيبًا أَوْ مَرِيضًا أَوْ مَحْبُوسًا وَمَا خَدَمْنَاكَ؟ حِينَئِذٍ يُجِيبُهُمْ قَائِلًا: أَلْحَقْ أَقُولُ لَكُمْ: كُلُّ مَا لَمْ تَعْمَلُوهُ لِأَحَدٍ هَؤُلَاءِ الصِّغَارِ، فَلِي لَمْ تَعْمَلُوهُ. وَيَذْهَبُ هَؤُلَاءِ إِلَى الْعَذَابِ الْأَبَدِيِّ، وَالْأَبْرَارُ إِلَى الْحَيَاةِ الْأَبَدِيَّةِ."

إنجيل الدينونة ليس لتخوفنا، بل لتشجيعنا لقبول يسوع ملكًا على حياتنا، ونعيش حبه في كلامنا وأفعالنا، فإذا أتت النهاية ندخل الملكوت ونعيش مع الملك إلى ما لا نهاية. آمين
