
**CANA SUNDAY: ENTRANCE INTO THE GREAT LENT**

## THE GOSPEL

On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding. When the wine gave out, the mother of Jesus said to him, "They have no wine." And Jesus said to her, "Woman, what concern is that to you and to me? My hour has not yet come." His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you." Now standing there were six stone water jars for the Jewish rites of purification, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. Jesus said to them, "Fill the jars with water." And they filled them up to the brim. He said to them, "Now draw some out, and take it to the chief steward." So they took it. When the steward tasted the water that had become wine, and did not know where it came from (though the servants who had drawn the water knew), the steward called the bridegroom and said to him, "Everyone serves the good wine first, and then the inferior wine after the guests have become drunk. But you have kept the good wine until now." Jesus did this, the first of his signs, in Cana of Galilee, and revealed his glory; and his disciples believed in him. After this he went down to Capernaum with his mother, his brothers, and his disciples; and they remained there a few days.

### Great Lent in our Marounite Church - Fr Sam WEHBE

The season of the Great Lent begins on Cana Sunday.

WHAT IS THE MEANING OF ASH MONDAY AND WHY ON A MONDAY? We begin lent by having the ashes placed on our foreheads which symbolises repentance for our sins. Through this, we declare to others and to ourselves that we are contemplating and allowing God to work His spiritual greatness. The Blessing of Ashes is originally a Latin (Western) Rite celebrated on Ash Wednesday. The Maronites adopted this celebration from the Western Church and moved it to the day after Cana Sunday, the day we start fasting, which is why we have Ash Monday.

## KEY FOCUSES IN LENT: PRAYER, FASTING AND ALMSGIVING

- 1. Prayer: During lent, we are called to increase our prayers and to be more involved in spiritual activities, bible study, Stations of the Cross on Fridays and charity as a sign of repentance and in preparation for the resurrection of the Lord.
- 2. Fasting and abstinence: Fasting is refraining from eating between 12 midnight and 12 noon (except for water and medicine). Abstinence is refraining from eating meat or dairy or drinking alcohol until the end of lent or on certain days, like the early Christians who practiced regular weekly fasts on Wednesdays and Fridays.

For us as Maronites, we can fast and abstain from eating meat and dairy the whole of lent. It is obligatory to fast and abstain from eating meat and dairy on Ash Monday and Good Friday, and abstain from eating meat and dairy on all Fridays in lent.

3. Almsgiving: Almsgiving is sharing what God has given us with the poor and the needy.

### **EXEMPTIONS FROM FASTING AND ABSTINENCE**

We do not fast or abstain on Saturdays and Sundays and Feast days such as St Maroun, St Joseph, the Annunciation... during lent. In addition, the elderly, sick, pregnant and children under 14 are not obliged to fast or abstain during lent.

ركائز زمن الصوم: ألصّلاة والصّيام والصّدقة

 الصلاة: خلال زمن الصوم، نحن مدعوون لنزيد صلواتنا ولنشارك أكثر في النشاطات الروحيّة والسّهرات الإنجيلية والصّلوات مثل مراحل درب الصّليب أيام الجمعة والصّوم والصدقة كعلامة توبة واستعدادًا لقيامة الربّ.

٢- ألصِيام والقطاعة: أُلصِيّام هو الإمتناع عن الأكل من الساعة ١٢ ليلًا وحق الساعة ١٢ ظهرًا (بِإستْثناء الماء والدواء). أما القطاعة فَهي الإمتناع عن أكل اللحوم والكحول والحلوبات حق نهاية الصّوم أو في بعض الأيام كالمسيحيين الأولين الذين كانوا يصومون كل أربعاء وجمّعة. في كنيستنا المارونيّة، نصوم ونقطع عن اللحوم ومشتقّات الحليب (البياض) خلال كلّ فترة الصِّيام. ألصِّيام والقطاعة الإجبارية عن اللحوم والبياض هما في يومَى إثنين الرماد والجمعة العظيمة، والقطاعة عن اللحوم والبياض كلّ يوم جمعة طوال فترة الصّوم.

٣ ألصَّدقة: ألصَّدقة هي مشاركة ما أعطانا إيَّاه الرّب مع الفقراء والمحتاجين ومساعدة

ألتفسيحات في الصوم والقطاعة

نحن لا نصوم ونقطع أيام السبوت والآحاد و أيام الأعياد مثل مار مارون ومار يوسف والبشارة... كما أنَّ العجَزة والمرضى والحَبالي والأطفال، هم غير مجبورون على الصوّوم والقطاعة.

**Dear Brothers and Sisters,** 

With Cana Sunday, we enter into the Season of Great Lent in our Maronite Church, a time for us to pause, reflect on our lives and strengthen our relationship with God and with others.

Bishop's Message - Golden Jubilee Year - Cana Sunday

In his Lenten message for 2023, our Maronite Patriarch, His Eminence and Beatitude Mar Bechara Boutros Cardinal Rai, reminds us of the Lord's words that "man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." (Matt 4:4) With this answer, the Lord teaches us that we are in need of 2 types of nourishment: one for our physical bodies and another for our spiritual soul. They are both needed to sustain us.

The need for food and physical nourishment is now, more than ever, a necessity for many of our own people in Lebanon and in many parts of the world. The political, economic, and social crises, as well as wars and natural disasters have left many hungry and unable to provide their basic necessities. The Patriarch reminds us that "The time of Great Lent puts each of us in a state of duty to help our brothers and sisters out of justice, solidarity and responsibility. Fasting itself includes charity, which is the sharing of what we have with those who are in need, whether it is a lot or a little."

Our Eparchy is holding an appeal to support families in Lebanon with charitable boxes and envelopes available at the church doors. Aware that families in Australia are also feeling some financial strain due to the rising cost of living, we thank you for any support or donation you can make to families in need in Lebanon.

The second necessary nourishment is "every word that comes from the mouth of God" (Matthew 4:4). His Holiness Pope Francis speaks about the duty to listen to the word of God, because by hearing it, we repent and change the course of our lives, our actions and our point of view (January 22, 2023). His Holiness affirmed that the word of God is for everyone and it is our duty to make sure that the word of God is shared, proclaimed and put at the centre of our lives.

When Jesus fasted forty days and forty nights, he was in a state of prayer. Fasting necessitates prayer, in order for a person to be open to the word of God and listen to it with their heart. It is by listening to the word of God that we can be filled with love for others and carry out acts of charity. Fasting, prayer and almsgiving go together in our Lenten journey.

**Lenten Penitential Practices** 

In regards to the Lenten penitential practices for the Maronites, and in accordance with the guidelines released by His Beatifude and Eminence Mar Bechara Boutros Cardinal Rai, the recommended practices are summarised below: Fasting from midnight to midday on all weekdays from Ash Monday to the Saturday of Light (8 April): no food or drink is to be consumed, with the exception of water;

Abstaining from consuming meat and dairy on the Fridays of Lent; and throughout the first and last week of Lent (Holy Week);

Fasting and Abstinence on Saturdays and Sundays are not an obligation, with the exception of the Saturday of Light (Easter Saturday), where fasting and abstinence are to be observed; In 2023, the following feast days fall within the Lenten Season: St John Maroun (2 March), The Forty Martyrs (9 March), St Joseph (19 March), St Rafga (23 March), The Annunciation (25 March). We do not fast or abstain on these feast days.

It is important to note that food and water are always permitted when needed to take medicines or in case of illness or old age or school children. A person who cannot fast or abstain may choose another form of penance.

I pray that this Lent is filled with spiritual blessings. May the words we hear on Ash Monday "you are dust and to dust you shall return" be our constant reminder over these coming 40 days that this world is passing. Every action we do here on earth is a preparation for eternal life in heaven.


